The **TCEQ (Texas Commission on Environmental Quality) Sunset Review Town Hall Meeting** will take place on **Thursday, September 23th from 6:30 – 8:30pm** at the **Cliff Morton Development & Business Services Center**, 1901 South Alamo Street, San Antonio, Texas. We will follow a ***citizens to be heard*** format, allowing ten minutes each for presentation from government agencies and citizens groups. Individuals will be accorded three minutes each. State Representatives and Senators in attendance will have the opportunity to ask questions and converse with each presenter as they see fit. We are aware of the breadth of topics that will be covered in this meeting, and are prepared to keep things moving so that all concerns can be heard.

The Greater Edwards Aquifer Alliance (GEAA) , our member groups, and the members of the Alliance for Clean Texas and others invite you to join us in hosting a **town hall meeting about the Sunset Review for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)**. We are also inviting Hill Country area State Representatives and Senators to co-host. The meeting will provide an opportunity for local and county elected officials and constituents from San Antonio and surrounding communities to recount their experiences with TCEQ, and to share their suggestions for improving this agency, in light of TCEQ's upcoming Sunset Review.
