Taxes, support for the Permanent School Fund, bonds for water projects, pardons, and terms of office for elected officials are among the important issues that Texans will decide in November 8 Constitutional Amendment Election. “What voters decide will have significant impact on all of us, and LWV-Texas urges all registered voters who have not yet voted to cast an informed ballot on Election Day,” says Karen Nicholson, President of LWV-Texas.

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 7p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8.

To help prepare voters to cast an informed ballot, LWV-Texas’ nonpartisan *Voters Guide* is available in both English and Spanish at [www.lwvtexas.org](http://www.lwvtexas.org). The League’s *Voters Guide* provides the official ballot language, a nontechnical explanation, and unbiased arguments “for” and “against” each of the ten proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution. Important information on voter photo ID requirements scheduled to take effect in 2012 is also included.

For 90 years the League has been agitating and educating for informed public participation in government and believes there is no more important form of participation than informed voting!
